

Important Information Regarding Camp Broadway 2019

Grand Finale

Your camper will be working hard all week, learning new skills in acting, singing and dancing. At the end of the week, they will be ready to put on the Family Finale, which will include younger campers starring in *Roald Dahl's Willy Wonka* and older campers starring in *Chitty Chitty Bang Bang Jr!* In addition, campers will split into small groups and produce a skit. They will be given two Broadway shows and are tasked with mashing the two stories together in a fun, original way. It will be a fun evening for all! The Family Finale will run from 4pm-5:30pm at the FSCJ Nathan H. Wilson Center for the Arts, 11901 Beach Boulevard on the Main Stage. Doors open at 3:45pm. and seating is first come, first seated, so plan to arrive right at opening time!

Tickets

Since the Wilson Center has a limited number of seats and we would like to ensure that all families are given an equal opportunity to see their child perform, we are limited to four admission tickets per camper. Tickets will be mailed to the address provided on your child's application.

If you will not use all of the tickets, please return them to Amanda Scott or Ashley Williams upon check-in or check-out on Monday, June 10.

Parent Orientation

We invite you to attend the Parent Orientation following check-in on Monday, June 10. Orientation is optional, but encouraged – especially for first time camp participants, and will be from 9am-9:30 a.m. We will cover what to expect for the week and you will have a chance to meet some of the Camp Broadway staff.

Attire

Campers are provided with two official Camp Broadway t-shirts during Monday morning registration. Campers are to wear the official t-shirt each day, paired with comfortable shorts (school standard appropriate) or pants that can be worn for dancing. Either sneakers or dance shoes may be worn, but sandals and all open-toed shoes are prohibited. Costume suggestions for the family finale will be provided closer to camp finale and should be items you can find in your own closet so you do not need to buy anything new.

Group Assignments

We are currently working on creating the groups for this summer. You will be informed via email prior to camp with your camper's group assignment. On Monday morning, your child will go to the table labeled with their group name to check in.

Drop off and Pick up

Doors open promptly at 8:30 a.m. and pick up begins at 5 p.m. We are unable to accommodate early drop-off requests and cannot be responsible for campers outside of camp hours. Please plan to be prompt for both drop off and pick up. If there is an issue (traffic, weather, etc.), please call to let us know. If your child needs to leave early at any point during the week, please let us know as far ahead as possible. We want your child to miss the least amount of time possible as to be fully prepared for the finale on Friday.

Please note: for every child's safety, the roundabout in front of the entrance of the Wilson Center is **not** a drop off or pick up location. We ask that you keep traffic moving and park in the lot next to the entrance when dropping off or picking up your camper. There will be a security guard and volunteers at the entrance to keep traffic flowing. Please also be mindful of cars when crossing the parking lot and stay on the sidewalk once you reach it.

Food

Lunch is provided by Anthony's catering each day. Your camper will also receive an afternoon snack and one bottle of water each day that they are welcome to refill as many times as they would like during the day. Breakfast will not be provided. Please make sure your child has breakfast prior to their check in, as they will go straight into the camp day and there will be no time for them to eat once they check in.

Permission to leave

You indicated on your application whether or not your camper has permission to leave on their own. If you indicated that they **can** leave, then your camper will be able to meet you in the parking lot after camp. If you indicated that they **cannot** leave, then you will need to park and come inside for signout and to pick them up. To change your permission status, please ask for a permission slip at checkout.
