

Waitress Pie Contest

Official Rules: No purchase necessary. A purchase will not improve one's chances on winning.

- Pie recipe and name of pie must be completely original, created and tested by the person entering the contest.
- Contest open to amateur bakers only.
- All entries must be received by 11:59pm on February 13 to be eligible for the contest.
- One entry per person
- Must be a Jacksonville, FL resident and age 18 or older to enter the contest.
- Three (3) finalists will be selected by FSCJ Artist Series staff and panel of expert bakers and will participate in a final judging round on First Coast Living.
- Must be available February 26 at 10:15am-12:00pm to attend the live taste testing on First Coast Living starting at 11am and located at WTLV/WJXX, 1070 E Adams St, Jacksonville, FL 32202.
- If you are not available, you must arrange for someone to represent you and your pie recipe on the show. They will need to attend the taste testing for you and bring the pie you baked.
- Three (3) finalists will be selected by FSCJ Artist Series staff and panel of expert bakers and will participate in a final judging round on First Coast Living.
- One (1) winner will be selected to win four (4) tickets to opening night of Waitress on March 12 at 7:30 p.m., a \$100 gift certificate to Taverna and the winning recipe will be inserted in *Waitress* cookbook sold at the Times-Union Center during the Jacksonville engagement of *Waitress*. The first and second runner ups will each receive two (2) tickets to opening night of Waitress on March 12 at 7:30pm at the Times-Union Center.
- The winner will be announced on First Coast Living on February 26 and will be decided by a panel of judges. The decision of the judges is final.
- Employees of WTLV/WJXX and Florida State College at Jacksonville and members of their immediate families (spouses, parents, children, and siblings and their spouses) are not eligible.
